

## “Repent”

NIV 1 Kings 8:47 and if they have a change of heart in the land where they are held captive, and **repent** and plead with you in the land of their conquerors and say, 'We have sinned, we have done wrong, we have acted wickedly';

<sup>37</sup> NIV Job 34:33 Should God then reward you on your terms, when you refuse to **repent**? You must decide, not I; so tell me what you know.

NIV Job 36:10 He makes them listen to correction and commands them to **repent** of their evil.

NIV Job 42:6 Therefore I despise myself and repent in dust and ashes."

NIV Isaiah 59:20 "The Redeemer will come to Zion, to those in Jacob who **repent** of their sins," declares the LORD.

NIV Jeremiah 5:3 O LORD, do not your eyes look for truth? You struck them, but they felt no pain; you crushed them, but they refused correction. They made their faces harder than stone and refused to **repent**.

NIV Jeremiah 15:19 Therefore this is what the LORD says: "If you **repent**, I will restore you that you may serve me; if you utter worthy, not worthless, words, you will be my spokesman. Let this people turn to you, but you must not turn to them.

NIV Ezekiel 14:6 "Therefore say to the house of Israel, 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: **Repent!** Turn from your idols and renounce all your detestable practices!

NIV Ezekiel 18:30 "Therefore, O house of Israel, I will judge you, each one according to his ways, declares the Sovereign LORD. **Repent!** Turn away from all your offenses; then sin will not be your downfall.

NIV Ezekiel 18:32 For I take no pleasure in the death of anyone, declares the Sovereign LORD. **Repent** and live!

NIV Hosea 11:5 "Will they not return to Egypt and will not Assyria rule over them because they refuse to **repent**?

NIV Matthew 3:2 and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near."

NIV Matthew 4:17 From that time on Jesus began to preach, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is near."

NIV Matthew 11:20 Then Jesus began to denounce the cities in which most of his miracles had been performed, because they did not repent.

NIV Matthew 21:32 For John came to you to show you the way of righteousness, and you did not believe him, but the tax collectors and the prostitutes did. And even after you saw this, you did not repent and believe him.

NIV Mark 1:15 "The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God is near. Repent and believe the good news!"

NIV Mark 6:12 They went out and preached that people should repent.

NIV Luke 13:3 I tell you, no! But unless you repent, you too will all perish.

NIV Luke 15:7 I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.

NIV Luke 16:30 " 'No, father Abraham,' he said, 'but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will **repent.**'

NIV Luke 17:4 If he sins against you seven times in a day, and seven times comes back to you and says, 'I **repent,**' forgive him."

NIV Acts 2:38 Peter replied, "**Repent** and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

NIV Acts 3:19 **Repent,** then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord,

NIV Acts 8:22 **Repent** of this wickedness and pray to the Lord. Perhaps he will forgive you for having such a thought in your heart.

NIV Acts 17:30 In the past God overlooked such ignorance, but now he commands all people everywhere to **repent.**

NIV Acts 26:20 First to those in Damascus, then to those in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and to the Gentiles also, I preached that they should **repent** and turn to God and prove their **repentance** by their deeds.

NIV Revelation 2:5 Remember the height from which you have fallen! **Repent** and do the things you did at first. If you do not **repent,** I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place.

NIV Revelation 2:16 **Repent** therefore! Otherwise, I will soon come to you and will fight against them with the sword of my mouth.

NIV Revelation 2:21 I have given her time to **repent** of her immorality, but she is unwilling.

NIV Revelation 2:22 So I will cast her on a bed of suffering, and I will make those who commit adultery with her suffer intensely, unless they **repent** of her ways.

NIV Revelation 3:3 Remember, therefore, what you have received and heard; obey it, and **repent.** But if you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what time I will come to you.

NIV Revelation 3:19 Those whom I love I rebuke and discipline. So be earnest, and **repent.**

NIV Revelation 9:20 The rest of mankind that were not killed by these plagues still did not **repent** of the work of their hands; they did not stop worshipping demons, and idols of gold, silver, bronze, stone and wood--idols that cannot see or hear or walk.

NIV Revelation 9:21 Nor did they **repent** of their murders, their magic arts, their sexual immorality or their thefts.

NIV Revelation 16:9 They were seared by the intense heat and they cursed the name of God, who had control over these plagues, but they refused to **repent** and glorify him.

NIV Revelation 16:11 and cursed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, but they refused to **repent** of what they had done.
